There has been so much growth happening here over the past few months, and our hearts are full to see young believers eagerly wanting to learn more and help in the church. There are several men that have expressed a desire to start Bible college classes, and Bro. Kenneth Ellzey and I are currently exploring different options for beginning a Bible Institute through the church. There really is nothing more exciting than seeing new believers wanting to grow and serve!

Construction has continued at the church since our last letter. The exterior front wall at the church needed to be replaced and is almost finished. We also held a church workday last Saturday to pour a new sidewalk that leads to the kid's class area and the kitchen. What a blessing that sidewalk will be during the rainy season that is quickly approaching!

In mid-September, we held a special service and Iglesia Bautista Fe Viva was officially formed. The first official members signed the church's charter to complete the service. We celebrated with a lunch of roasted pig provided by one of the church members. Since then, several more people have joined the church, and several more have been saved and baptized!

In October, the six-week English Course we offered came to an end, and we held a special graduation Sunday to recognize the hard work of the students. During the service, a clear gospel message was shared with them and their families. Already, several of the students have come to some special events, and we are praying that God will do a work in their hearts and lives.

So many of you have reached out asking about Hudson's eyes, and we greatly appreciate your prayers and concern! He was prescribed glasses during our recent trip to Santa Cruz, but we have not seen much of an improvement. This past week, we were able to meet with a team of eye doctors from the UK who were here doing an eye clinic in a nearby town. They confirmed that Hudson will need some further testing soon, but unfortunately, they did not have the equipment there to diagnose his condition. We are praying for wisdom on what to do next as we feel many of our options here have been exhausted. We ask that you pray with us that God will give clear leading on how to proceed next.
