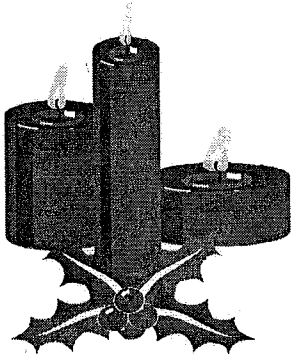

Christmas Greetings from the Island of Pohnpei!

Family: We arrived safely back in Pohnpei September 17th. Our family is doing well other than the normal adjustments with moving back to the tropics. Our main problem is readjusting to the heat. Affordable housing was in short supply, but we found an apartment that will be adequate for our family. We left our youngest son Nathaniel at Northland Baptist Bible College in Wisconsin. He is finishing up his first semester and is doing very well. Aaron, his wife Lynn and our granddaughter Gabby, along with Andrew are living and working in Lynchburg, Virginia. Please pray for them as they seek God's will for their lives.

Ministry: After arriving back, we are continuing the services in the village of Tomworolong in Kittu. The people said that they had missed us and were excited that we came back to minister to them. We've had a high attendance of eighty people and have seen four adults receive Christ since our return. We had a lady who came to our home by taxi a few weeks ago. She said that she was on her way to work, but that she could not go until she found out how to ask Jesus into her life. She said that she was from the village of Tomworolong and that her daughter has been attending our services. She would come home and tell her about the messages. There in our living room, with tears streaming down her face, she bowed her head and received Christ. What better way to spend Thanksgiving Day than to lead a soul to Jesus. Praise the Lord! We continue to help Clayton with the work at Wone Baptist Church. We have seen several follow the Lord in believer's baptism since our return. The Lord continues to bless the ministry in Wone under Clayton's leadership. Please continue to remember him and his family in your prayers. We have also had the opportunity to minister through chapel and Bible class at Calvary Christian Academy. Since our return we have seen a number of young people accept Christ. My wife has been busy conducting choir at CCA preparing for the upcoming Christmas program. We praise the Lord for the open door of opportunity that He has given us to minister in these different areas.

Mission Highlight: While driving to Tomworolong the other day, I saw a man running down the road carrying a desk top fan. When I passed him, he stopped and started running the other way. I was puzzled for a moment, but then realized that he was running to make the blades of the fan spin. I guess that is one way to save on the electric bill.
