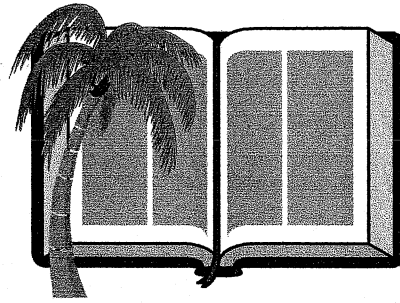

Dear Co-Laborers in Christ,

Greetings from the Island of Pohnpei!

Family:

I do have some prayer requests concerning our family since our last prayer letter. Our youngest son Nathaniel, who is a student at Northland Baptist Bible College, hurt his knee the last two weeks of school. He underwent major reconstructive surgery on his knee in Lynchburg, Virginia, in May. My wife Patty went to be with him during the surgery. He ran into some complications with infection and had to have a second surgery. He is now in the recovery process and is having rehab therapy three times a week. At the same time our oldest son Aaron has not been doing well with his disease. He is scheduled to see a specialist at Wake Forrest in July. Also, our daughter Priscilla has been having a lot of kidney infections. The doctors here on Pohnpei have approved her referral to the Philippines for further testing. Please pray as I continue to minister here on Pohnpei and as I take our daughter to the Philippines. Also pray for my wife as she continues to help Nathaniel and Aaron in Virginia. Pray for Nathaniel and his complete recovery from surgery and that the doctors will be able to find a way to help Aaron.

Ministry:

In the midst of all these trials with our family, we continue to see the Lord blessing in a tremendous way. We continue to see souls saved on a regular basis. We praise the Lord for how He is moving in the hearts of the people. The Kids' Club that we started in Tomworolong is going great! We are averaging about 35 kids each service. Our regular service in Tomworolong is going well also. We are continuing to survey the land in this village in order to pick the best location for a church building. Please persist in making this a matter of prayer.

Mission Highlight:

Our daughter Priscilla was admitted to the hospital here on Pohnpei late last month. After her first night's stay, I noticed she was out of tissue. I asked at the desk for more tissue paper and they said, "you are only allowed one roll per patient, per stay." I guess when that is gone, you either have to supply your own or go without!

Thank you so much for your continued prayer and sacrificial giving. May God continue to bless each of you as you serve Him.
