I was then referred to an Oncologist who scheduled me for a CT scan and biopsies. We praise the Lord that the scan and biopsies came back negative! The Oncologist said it was a miracle because she really expected me to have cancer. I told her it was an answer to prayer. We want to say thank you so much for praying for us during this time.

We do want to say that Nathaniel and Amanda's wedding went well and they are back at Northland Baptist Bible College finishing their education. Please continue to pray for Aaron, his wife Lynne and our granddaughter, Gabby. We would ask that you also pray for Andrew as he continues his education, and for our return trip to Pohnpei on March 6th.

**Ministry:** During our time here in the States I have been in constant contact with our National Pastor, Clayton Eliam, who I had the privilege of helping to train and ordain. He continues to do a great job at Wone and has been filling in for us in the village of Tomworolong. Upon our return to Pohnpei we will begin negotiations for the land given to us in Tomworolong by Mrs. Emeree Shedd. Mrs. Shedd attends Truth Baptist Church in the village of Lukop, her generosity is truly a blessing and we know the Lord will greatly bless her for her concern for lost souls in the village of Tomworolong. We will also begin preparing a building site for construction of a permanent church in this village.

On our way to the States we had the privilege of getting with some of our teens from Wone Baptist Church who are now attending Harvest Baptist Bible Institute on Guam. Several of these students will be graduating in May and returning to Pohnpei to be a help at Wone. We praise the Lord that He has allowed us to have a pro-active part in the spiritual growth of these young men and women through the preaching and teaching of the Word of God. We ask that you continue to pray for the ministries in Wone and Tomworolong as we return.
