What a joy it is to see those new babes in Christ grow and mature into faithful servants of the Lord. What a joy it is to know that you have a part in all those lives that have been changed. During our absence I have left the ministry at Tomworolong in good hands with Clayton EIAM (the national that I have worked with for the last seven years). We are in constant contact via e-mail concerning the ministry in Tomworolong. It is our desire to return to Pohnpei as soon as possible after Aaron has recovered from his surgeries and is situated. During our time here we will be contacting our supporting churches for meetings in 2009.

Again, we want to thank each of you for your faithfulness to be a part of this ministry throughout the year. Your giving during these difficult economic times is a true testimony of your love for lost souls and fulfilling the Great Commission. We pray that God will bless you in a tremendous way this Christmas!
