I have several things to bring you up-to-date on since our last prayer letter. It has been an exciting and busy time since my return to Pohnpei in March. I praise the Lord for the men at Good News Baptist Church who got together and built homemade pews for our Church. What a blessing it is now to be able to come and sit on pews and not have to bring our mats and sit on the ground during service. I have filed all the paper work in order to get an earth moving permit in order to have our road built to access the property for Good News. We are currently waiting for the 2 last signatures in order to proceed. We praise the Lord for Trinity Baptist Church in Warrenton, Virginia who gave a generous love gift toward this project. We also give the Lord all the glory and praise for the 12 souls that we have seen come to know Christ since March!! We praise the Lord that He is still in the saving business and He has allowed us to be a part of this work!!

I also wanted to bring you up-to-date on Patty's medical condition since our last prayer letter. The PVC's in her heart have been somewhat controlled by her medication. However in February she was diagnosed with Rheumatoid Arthritis. The doctor has put her on oral meds to see if this will help control her symptoms. Also, in March she was diagnosed with skin cancer on her arms and legs. The doctor said this was caused by years of exposure to the tropical rays of the sun here on Pohnpei. The doctors have started her on a Chemo skin treatment, doing one limb at a time to see if this will work. The Chemo treatment is making her very sick to her stomach and causing a lot of sores in her mouth. After her last visit to the doctor they had to stop her rheumatoid medication because together with the Chemo medication it was causing her White blood count to drop to low. Please continue to hold her up in your prayers.
