Luke 2:10 And the angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people.

We pray that each of you had a wonderful Thanksgiving with family and friends. As we approach Christmas Day, I pray that you will take time to reflect on the "Meaning of the Season" which is the birth of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Though we live in a time of uncertainty we can take refuge in the fact that we serve a King of certainty!!!!!!!

I wanted to bring you up-to-date on Patty's medical condition since our last prayer letter. She had her appointment at UVA (University of Virginia Medical Center) where the doctor confirmed that the places on her skin is "Porokeratosis", but the good news is that the recent studies show that it does not turn to cancer as often as previous studies in the past had shown. With that news her doctor in Lynchburg did pretesting in order to start her on Methotrexate, but her skin test for TB (tuberculosis) showed positive. Because of the positive test she has to undergo TB therapy for 3 months before she can start the RA medication and has to remain on the TB medication for up to a year. During this time Patty will be unable to return to Pohnpei because the medication will lower her immune system and make her susceptible to the various diseases that are found on Pohnpei. We appreciate all your prayers for Patty and ask that you continue to pray for her health and healing.

We Praise the Lord that He continues to bless the ministry at Good News. I thank the Lord for Salomon David and his faithfulness to Pastor at Good News in my absence. Because of modern technology we are able to communicate via internet on a regular basis which makes it easy for Salomon to keep me updated on the services and allows me to answer any questions that he may have. The people continue to enjoy the new road which enables them to have easy access to the church. It's exciting to hear that the people are being faithful to the services and that new visitors are attending on a regular basis. I covet your prayers as I will be flying back to Pohnpei in January. My goals for this trip will be to have an Ordination service for Salomon David, construct a small thatch building at Good News for our children's Sunday school and to make some more improvements on the main church building. Pray for me as I balance the ministry on Pohnpei and Patty's health needs at this time.
