Dear Co-Laborers in Christ,

Since our last prayer letter we have spent many hours praying about what Gods direction would be for our lives due to Patty's health issues. We still had a burden to finish the work at Good News, but were not sure how to go about this since Patty is unable to permanently live on Pohnpei due to her health. God has answered our prayers and opened the door for us to move our home base to Guam, which will take place in May. This will be beneficial in a number of ways; Patty will be able to get the medication she needs, she will have adequate medical care, we will be available to help with ministry needs on Guam and it will locate us only a 3 hour flight from Pohnpei which will enable me to continue helping at Good News until I'm able to train a National to take over that work. Lord willing we will also be constructing a permanent building in the near future.

God continues to bless the ministry at Good News. In February we had the opportunity of having the President of our Mission Agency, Danny Whetstone, preach at Good News while making a trip through Micronesia. During the service we had the privilege of seeing three ladies come forward for salvation during the invitation. We are so thankful for the faithful members of Good News who have been consistent in their witness for Christ.

I Praise the Lord for the project we were able to get finished in March. Our church currently has a dirt floor, so I wanted to build a platform for the Pulpit to sit on and to have a place for the Preacher and Choir members to stand. I was able to purchase all the material and with the help of Lucas Dolan (our song leader), Kesner Santos, Salomon David and Mason Dolan we were able to build the platform. A few days later I was able to spend the day sanding and painting the platform. After painting the platform I decided to surprise everyone and paint our homemade pews to match the platform. I was so excited to watch the faces of everyone as they arrived on Sunday morning and saw the painted platform and pews for the first time. They were so thankful and excited that it made the appearance of the church look so nice even with a dirt floor.
