However, she is experiencing increased pain and numbness in her feet. Her RA doctor on Oahu and her neurologist here on Kauai have exhausted their knowledge in trying to determine the cause of the pain in her feet. Her doctor on Oahu wants to stop her infusions and start her on a new drug call Xeljanz, but recommended that she contact the doctors at the Polymyositis research center in Pittsburg before starting the new drug. The doctors in Pittsburg have contacted her and told her not to start any new drugs until they evaluate her feet. They have scheduled her with an appointment for May 27th.

Pray for the ministry of Amazing Grace Baptist Church as we continue to serve the Lord here on Kauai. Pray for our folks to remain faithful in their walk with the Lord. Please pray for those that are newly saved that we will see spiritual growth in their lives.
