Psalm 56:3 What time I am afraid, I will trust in thee.

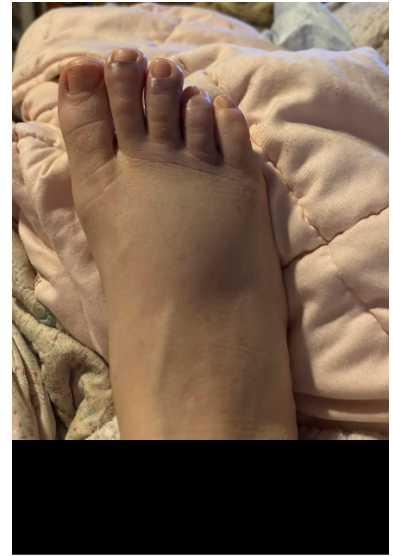

Patty's dad, Blake Mullins passed away in March in Carrollton Georgia at the age of 95 after a long life of faithful service to the Lord. They asked if I would preach the message at the funeral, so we flew to Georgia in April for the funeral. We praise the Lord for the opportunity to share the gospel message at his funeral. Patty continues to have issues with her blood counts and her kidneys not functioning properly. After a number of blood test her oncologist scheduled her for a bone marrow biopsy. She had that done June 1st and we are praying and waiting for the results. Also, while getting ready to go to the doctor she tripped over a laundry basket and broke three toes. I had knee surgery on my left knee on April 24th to remove a giant cell tumor, but it was not cancerous. I have regained about 50 percent use of my knee so far. So, that why I mentioned that this year has definitely had its challenges. We are trusting the Lord through all this and hold to the promise that he is in control and nothing takes Him by surprise! We do appreciate all your prayers during this time for healing and waiting for answers.
