I have been able to visit his Mother and Sister here in the city. I got in the first time, but did not find them home when I returned. I am thankful to be able to minister by computer telephone as well as ham radio I have ten people in Canada and the U.S. with whom I pray and have Bible study.**

**We were down to visit with Mr. Nickerson yesterday. It is an half hour drive. He came to church until he had a leg removed. He will be 95 in February. He loves to sing the old hymns. His daughter, a lovely Christian lady, has moved to be with him.**


**A couple is leaving to-morrow for Florida. They will be gone for the Winter.**
