Thank you so much for your prayers. A brush fire continued several days, but did not cross to our side of the road. The land behind the church contains one hundred acres of brush. After the first day, the wind blew the fire away from us, but before it was out, it took eight houses, and damaged ten others. Praise God that all the lives were saved. It gave opportunity to witness out here in the street.

Water is coming through the church ceiling and plaster is falling. We have had several check out the steeple, but we have not found the final solution. We could use a new roof, but those that attend do not have the resources.

Please pray for Eric. He came to one service, and we have talked by phone. He is from Trinidad. Roger came for a short time, but he has moved away. He told me that he and his friend, Donna, have their problems to overcome. They have returned to the French Shore. The man in France called me a couple of days ago. High on my list is to visit his mother and sister. They are a little distance by bus.

We had avoided Windsor on our last trip to the Valley, as students brought Swine Flu back from Mexico. One man I intended to visit died that week. That is three Christian men in Windsor who have died this year. They all had a good testimony. We praise God that we have been kept from sickness, though we visit four different nursing homes each month.

Thank you for every way in which you support us. We want to be found faithful when our Savior comes.
