From there we traveled to Atlanta, where we had the opportunity to visit some churches during the first week in September. This was to introduce ourselves and to hopefully schedule meetings for the future. While in Atlanta we made a quick trip to Greenwood, SC on September 4, where we had the opportunity to present our work to the good folks at Calvary Baptist Church, pastored by Kevin Hembree. On September 5, we presented our work to people of Calvary's Harvest Baptist Church (Pastor Craig Bennett) in Atlanta and what a joy to be with these folks!

On September 8, Scott had the privilege of preaching the whole day at Grace Baptist Temple in Blackstone, VA. This church is without a pastor, and we came to help - - that is what we do. Grace has since taken us on for support, and we thank God for His provision. On the 15th, we presented our work to Lighthouse Baptist Church in Laurens, SC and visited Eastside Baptist Church in Greenwood, SC on Sunday night. We traveled to Emporia, VA on September 18, where Scott had the privilege of filling in for Pastor John Kinsey. We will return there in January to present our work. The rest of September was spent in the low

country of South Carolina. What a joy it was to be with the Gantt Street Baptist Church family on the 22nd for their missions Sunday. Scott filled in for Pastor Joey Curado of Calvary Baptist Church on Wednesday, the 25th. This is one of our supporting churches. We had the privilege of not only presenting our work at Welch Creek Baptist Church on the 29th, but Scott was able to fill in for Pastor James Baker while he and his wife were away. What a blessing it was to be in these many churches.

Scott had the privilege of speaking at Trinity Baptist Church on October 2, and then filled in for Pastor Dave Varnell of Cross Pointe Baptist Church in Fremont, NC the following night, October 3. We hope to go back to Cross Pointe sometime after the new year to present our work. We then traveled to the Orangeburg Baptist Tabernacle in SC where we had the honor of being in their annual mission's conference from October 6-9. It was a blessed time with other missionaries, and the preaching was great. On October 13, we traveled to Shelby, NC where we presented our work at Cornerstone Baptist Church Sunday morning and then at Faith Baptist Church Sunday night. We then had the opportunity to sit under some wonderful preaching and make some good contacts from October 14 - 16 at the Southwide Baptist Fellowship held at Grace Baptist Church in Columbia, SC.

The rest of the month of October was spent helping another church that is presently without a pastor. Please pray for Faith Baptist Church in Trenton, NC. We look forward to helping these dear people and will do so whenever there are no deputation meetings scheduled.
