We fly from Guam to Saipan, and our plans are to stay in Saipan for five days. This will give us opportunity to visit and spend time with the many folks we ministered to for twenty years. We will also have opportunity to see old friends and get reacquainted with island life. We will arrive in Tinian on September 27.
