We have accepted this call, and Lord willing, we will be leaving the States on January 28, 2025. We will be traveling to Corby, England to relieve missionary Roger Tooley and his wife, Tammy. The plans are for us to stay there six months. Please pray for us as we plan. Please pray that God will supply our financial needs for this trip. We are looking forward to helping the Tooleys and wanted you to know now so that you can earnestly pray.

We do have some meetings scheduled for April and early May. We also hope to have a slate of meetings scheduled from August through November. We are not boasting; we are letting you know what we are planning by God's grace. Pray for us that we will follow His will and be true to our calling each and every day.

Because of my continued recovery from surgery, we do not have anything planned for March. Because of this, we will not write again until the end of April. Thank you for your encouragement.
