Who would have thought that we would be spending our fiftieth on a tropical island? It may not be quite paradise, but we did our best to make it so. We tried to make the day and the following week special. We had a nice anniversary lunch at one of the local resort restaurants. We then spent a couple of days at one of the other island resorts. On Sunday, June 9, the church here (Calvary Baptist Church) blessed us with an island fiesta celebration of our fifty years together. We praise God for the gifts, the food, and the wonderful kindness extended to us. The church went all out on our behalf. They even turned the auditorium into a banquet hall (we have pictures attached)! God has been good to us, patient with us, and blessed us beyond measure. We thank Him that His mercy endureth forever.
