begun making plans to go to Liberia, Africa, in the month of May. We have been asked to pray about coming to Liberia in 2027 to relieve missionary Carrie Whaley. This upcoming trip will be a survey trip. Carrie has asked us to come and get a feel of the ministry before making any final decisions. Carrie is a missionary to the deaf in Monrovia, and she has asked us to come and oversee the work and be a part of the hearing ministry. While we have no experience working with the deaf, our responsibility would be to manage the compound where deaf classes are held throughout the week, to assist in the Baptist church which ministers to both deaf and hearing alike, and to continue two (hearing) Bible studies that Carrie started. Pray that God would make known His will to us. We are very excited that God has opened this door for us. We praise God for answered prayer; thank you for praying. On February 23, we received our visas which are good for three years. We have also secured our airline tickets. The next thing on our agenda is to receive yellow fever vaccinations which are scheduled to be administered in April. We will be in Liberia for three weeks - - May 18 through June 9. Please pray that God would supply all the financial needs necessary to make this trip possible. Also pray that we will successfully navigate through all the logistical challenges associated with this upcoming trip. We are excited about this opportunity to help Carrie and ask that you pray that God would give us wisdom in the days and weeks ahead.

We ended the month presenting our work and sharing our overall ministry with a new church. On February 25, we had the privilege of being with Pastor Jeremy Kobernat and the good folks at Victory Baptist Church in Roanoke Rapids, NC. We praise God for giving us the opportunity to share our burden with them. We appreciate the kindness and hospitality shown to us by this missions-minded group of believers. God gave us a great night!!

We thank you for your continued prayers. We wish you the very best in the days ahead. Continue to pray as we minister in Smyrna, DE, and as we make preparation to travel to Liberia.
