If you recall in the first quarter letter I spoke of my trip to the tsunami affected region. So many of you made inquiries about this I thought I would give you an update. Well over \$50,000.00 was given to help our missionaries carry out temporary and permanent help for the Indian people. Dozens of boats were built and

repaired. Thousands received medical help and others were given food and clothing. Sadly, I must report to you the missionary whose ministry is carrying out this work buried his wife who succumbed to a heart attack. Please remember to pray for them and the outreach work that is still being done.

In April a tragedy occurred in Ghana, Africa with one of our families. Ronnie and Rebecca Walker's three year old daughter, Esther, died from complications due to Cystic Fibrosis. They buried her near their house in the village where they serve. I attended the funeral along with the President of our mission (*pictured*) and the Walker's Pastor and family members. Please remember to pray for strength as they attempt to discover a new normal.

God's hand has worked in our preaching and training ministry. This quarter I helped in several missions conferences which allowed me to see God touch His people to promise to give over \$100,000.00. I also spoke in nine churches for special Sunday services and rejoiced to see three saved in those services.

I am blessed to report to you a special time of training missionaries. I spoke four times to the missionaries with Prayer Baptist Missions International. I spoke on areas affecting missionaries and their sending churches along with developing a ministry to last a lifetime. I spoke in the evening services about trusting the wings of God. God blessed in a mighty and clear way.

Our Missions agency is holding our annual family week. I have been involved in the planning and preparing for this meeting. The theme for this week is, "*The High Calling of God.*" I will be preaching on "*The Philosophy of the High Calling.*" We will have over 120 of our Mission's family in attendance.

Without you we could not be in the places nor reach the people we do. We are grateful for your investments.
