The totalitarian regime of Fidel

life. Families receive I egg per
person per month. Meat is scarce
and in some cases families have not

received meat in 15 years. One mother told me, "In Cuba there are no options."

No options! What a contrast to our own country. Yet, the removal of all options from its people has not limited God.

The door for active ministry in Cuba is open. Men will be trained in the Word of God. Churches will be started. Souls will be given the option of Heaven. The cause is great, the needs are incredible, however, God is not limited by Castro's communism!

In January I spoke to over 70 pastors about our missions agency. I also spoke at college for missionaries in Milford, OH.

In February, I will speak at Ambassador Baptist College in their missions classes. I will also speak in three missions conferences.
