Much of our Tuesdays are spent with Rolando discipling a young man while the single-mom spends time with Hannah or running errands. Thursdays find us

packing up and heading to Lexington for Hannah to teach piano 9:30-3:15, coming home to eat supper, and heading to our home church for Rolando to teach two classes. Saturdays, we sometimes have the **privilege** of joining different churches for their regular door-to-door evangelism.
