I am thankful to God for His hand upon Hannah's body. She is now fully **recovered** from the miscarriage. It is especially a blessing because October has been one of our busiest months yet. We have traveled far, and by the end of this month, we will have been in twenty services in thirty-one days.

Hurricane Matthew met us while we were within thirty miles of open ocean — in Chesapeake, Virginia. There were trees down and flooded areas all around us, but we did not see the worst of it. The church we were in had to cancel the last service of their conference and postpone it until the next week. Most of the missionaries were able to share their ministry and preach, and the ones that did not were scheduled to come back on a later date. The church had some flooding in its auditorium, and they are waiting to hear from their insurance company to see how much repair they will help with. Pray that they would be dealt with bountifully. I cannot help but to think of what happened in other churches that suffered even more damage. I thank God for the hurricane because God allowed it, and if God allowed it, then it must be what is best. God used a hurricane to get the Gospel to Melita (Malta), and if we could see the fullness of what God has accomplished in Matthew, I am sure we would **bless His name** for His wisdom.
