

EXCEEDING ABUNDANTLY ABOVE

Paul tells us something amazing in Ephesians 3:20. He didn't just tell us God is able to do what we ask, or *more* than we ask, or more than *all* we ask. He does not stop at more than we ask or *think*. As literally mind blowing as that is, He adds "exceeding abundantly above." A great proof of this is that God has already done "exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think."
