On September 27th, I visited my brother in-law (husband of one of my sisters) at the Pohnpei hospital. My brother in-law has been sick for several months. He was in the Philippines for surgery during March 2011. His health has not improved since he came back from the Philippines. My brother in-law is not saved. Please pray that we will be able to lead him to Christ.

Continue to pray for our church people, for the Bible study that our young people are doing at PICS high school, for our individual time of sharing the Gospel, and for the ladies' Bible study that we are having at our house.

Our church will be hosting the next Baptist youth rally. This youth rally is scheduled to be held on November 2011. Pray that our church will be ready to host this gathering. All of our young people from our 6 Fundament Baptist Churches will be coming to our church for the rally.

Pray for transportation for church people and people in the community who expressed interest in attending our services. Some of these people do not have transportation to come to church on a regular basis. Most of them live about 2 to 3 miles from our church.

Please pray for the Iohp family, who is staying with us in Kolonia. This is a family of 7 people, and they don't have a house. They lived with family members before, and were asked to leave. They came to us for help, so we gave them my father's little house to live in. This family got saved and became members of our church. They have a piece of land near our church property in Palikir. They started building a little house on their property, but now stopped the building process, because they had a lack funds to continue building. Please pray for this family that they can complete their house.
