Pray that God's will be done, and He will be glorified in every aspect of this important endeavor. We started the work (with Paratext7 software) last week, June 17, 2012. It will probably take us 5-10 years to finish the work. Right now, we Pingelapese do not have a Bible in our own language. We use the Bible in Pohnpeian language or the English. It'll be a great blessing for the Pingelapese to read a Bible in their own language. My wife and I are both Pingelapese.

Pray also for the youth camp that will be held from July 16-21, and our revival that will be held from July 22-27. Pastor Donald Echert Jr. from Guahan Baptist Church in Guam will be speaking during these meetings. We are praying and looking forward to another great week of lasting revival.

We still covet your prayers for a mini bus (or a van) for our bus ministry. We have saved some funds toward the cost of it.

Today is our 31st wedding anniversary. Lihna and I were married on June 27, 1981. We thank the Lord for all the blessings, encouragement, adjustments, challenges, lessons learned, acceptance, and growth that He gave through us to give and to gain from each other throughout these years, as we serve Him together.

I am having problem with my right eye. There's a blurred spot in the vision in my right eye. I have visited a couple optical doctors on the island, and they are working on my papers to refer me abroad for medical help. Pray that the Lord's will be done.
