5. Youth Ministry

b.<u>Evangelism through sports</u>- Our son Haworth volunteered to coach some kids (9-15 yrs old) in our Kolonia neighborhood in basketball. He has 44 players both boys and girls. He's been coaching them for 2 months now. They meet in our house in Kolonia on Friday night for fun activities. This past Friday night I presented the gospel and we also provided snacks for them. Last Sunday (October 19th) twenty two of the kids attended our Sunday morning Sunday school class and also our morning service. Please pray for this outreach. Haworth and we need patience, strength and God's love to love these kids. Some them and their parents used to steal our kids clothes and food. They need to put their faith in the Lord and accept Him as their Lord and Saviour.</u>
