It has been a while since we last written you. Just to let you know that we are well and busy. Hope you are well too. Praise the Lord!

Thank you for praying for us. Continue to pray for our church family and the ministry. Below are some of the prayer needs and also some of the things we anticipate doing in the near future.

- 1.) Thank you for praying for our family and for our son Roland Padock. Roland has graduated from college and is with us this summer. Pray for him. He is very busy helping out in our churches with youth work and preaching etc. Last week he and James Harry and Chris (Yapese student came with Roland) took our youth group to Black Coral Resort to attend a youth retreat that was organized by our 7 Baptist Churches.

Roland reported that there were a total of 83 young people attended this youth retreat. There were 19 salvation decisions made and many dedicated their lives to the Lord during this retreat. Praise the Lord.

- 2.) Ministry at Pohnpei Baptist Bible Institute: I taught the pastoral epistles last quarter at the institute. There are no classes at the institute this summer. Classes will resume when school begins in August, 2019.
- 3.) Pingelapese Bible Translation Project: The Pingelapese Bible translation project is moving forward very well. The Translation Committee has translated the entire King James English Bible into the Pingelapese language. The committee is currently working on stage 2 which is review. Review work will cover 5 stages. I am currently reviewing the book of Romans chapter 9 to 16. The other committee members are reviewing the same chapters.
- 4.) Our Vacation Bible School this year (2019) is scheduled to be held from July 8 to 12, 2019. We are preparing and looking forward to minister to our church folks and also to whoever will come to this Vacation Bible School. Pray that we will have a good turn out and that many souls be saved for the glory of God.
