Dear Prayer Partners,

We are praising the Lord for the way He is working in our lives! Through the generous giving of our faithful supporters, we have now purchased the 4 solar panels needed in Nukuoro. We thank God for meeting this need. One church has provided funds for Bibles to go with us, and a couple in our home church provided a large generator for us to use there as well. God is so good!

We have been in contact with a missionary who just shipped a 20' container to another island near Nukuoro. They have given us the name of the company they used to ship it. We have determined that it will cost approximately \$15,000.00 to buy and ship the container with our supplies and household goods. This seems like an impossible amount, but we know that God is able to supply every need.

Supplies and household goods will be our next order of business. Since the island is very different from what we know here in the States, we will be taking camping supplies, an air mattress, iron cookware, plastic storage containers, plastic drawer units for storage, etc. Wood things just won't do the job over there. They have serious termites.

During June, we spent about 3 weeks in Tennessee helping a church remodel two bathrooms. This work was very close to being completed when

our time there was up. Several men worked many hours to complete this job, and we were happy to be a part of that team. We made contact with several churches in the area and were able to present our ministry to them.

Our September calendar is full, and I am now working on the rest of this year. Please pray with us about these future meetings. I also have one work project in either October or November. I should be able to give more definite information about this in my next letter.
