We praise the Lord for the new churches we were able to present the field of Nukuoro to during the month of September. God is continuing to give strength as we travel. Most of these churches are small in number, but they are big in heart. Pray that God will enable them to help us on our way.

For several years, we have been traveling and helping with maintenance and building in many churches and ministries. Our camping trailer and F350 truck have been the means by which to do this work. The Lord is leading us to sell them and get a vehicle that will be more economical for the remaining time we are in the US. Pray that God will send us a buyer, and we will be able to use this money to further the ministry most effectively.

Our most urgent need right now is for a 20' shipping container. We think that we can purchase one for about \$2000.00. Since supplies are coming in now, we need to be able to store them. We will also use this container for storage once it arrives on Pohnpei. After its arrival, we will unpack it and repack the supplies in small crates to ship them on to Nukuoro. Nukuoro does not have the facilities to accept delivery of a container. These seem like insurmountable obstacles, but we know that God has a plan to make this happen.
