Dear Friends,

Thank you all for your prayers on our behalf. We are truly grateful for everyone that holds us up to the Throne of Grace. We will be leaving on February 5th to start our journey back to Nukuoro. It has been a longer than expected furlough but God has led us and kept us all the way. His timing is perfect.

We have shipped three crates to California with our radio equipment, solar equipment, and other goods. We thank God for providing these things as well as the shipping costs to California. God is so good to us. We still need to pay for the shipment to Pohnpei and then down to Nukuoro. We are not sure what these costs will be at this time so pray that the Lord will provide for them.

Many have asked about my health. I am glad to report that things are looking much better and I am fully recovered from the knee replacement. I have good mobility and the swelling has decreased. The doctor said I should notice further improvement with that as more time goes by. We will need to purchase our first year's medications to take with us. I am on a blood pressure medicine and Melinda is on a high cholesterol medication and bone strengthener. The cost is higher because insurance does not pay for it this way.

The Lord has provided for our stay on Pohnpei while we wait for our freight to arrive and for the ship to go down to Nukuoro. We will be renting a small apartment from the pastor of one of the churches there. The rent will be more reasonable than living in a hotel so we are thankful for that. We will also be able to cook our own meals. Thankfully, it is in the main part of town so we will be able to walk most places or get a taxi.
