Dear Friends,

To God be the glory, great things He has done! The Lord has blessed me greatly since our last letter to you. I completed 14 weeks of physical therapy just before Christmas. My leg and arm strength have improved so much that they do not think I will need any more therapy. I was able to see the eye doctor, and he determined that there was no damage to my eye from the stroke. He only gave me a prescription for new glasses and told me that I could begin driving again. The dizziness and headaches I experienced for several months have almost completely gone away now. We are so grateful to the Lord for His healing. Thank you so much for your prayers on my behalf.

The ministry in Nukuoro has grown greatly in the past two years. Pastor Ray is now assisted by the young man I was discipling on Nukuoro. Please pray that Jarson will continue to grow spiritually. In the last letter, I mentioned that he desires to receive Bible training at Ambassador Baptist Church's Bible Institute on Pohnpei. We ask that everyone pray that God's will would be done in his life. Finances will be an issue for him, but we know that God can open doors and make a way if that is His will.

The Bible study groups on Pohnpei are doing well, and we are getting other materials ready for their use. Several of the folks in these groups have been very faithful to help with sending supplies to Nukuoro. We see fruit in both Nukuoro and Pohnpei.

In December, we met with a young man at Ambassador Baptist College in North Carolina. He believes that God is calling him to be a missionary in Nukuoro. Please pray that God will confirm this calling to him. We will be working with him. He still needs to complete his education. We see the hand of the Lord answering our prayers for laborers.

Please pray that God will give us clear direction. There is a camp ministry that is asking me to assist with planning in addition to our work with the ministry in Nukuoro. The Federated States of Micronesia is still closed to travelers. They are not allowing anyone into the country. We do not know when the travel ban will be lifted. We have much to pray about.

We know that God has a plan for us, and we want to follow His will. We miss our people on Nukuoro and ask that you pray for them as they seek to carry on without us. We also ask that you pray for us as we seek to give updates in churches and promote the ministry in the islands of Micronesia. God may be calling one of you to this wide-open field.
