Dear Prayer Partners,

Due to an oversight, our November prayer letter was not sent out on the intended date. We apologize for any inconvenience! We want to thank you all for your continued prayers for us. We have been traveling to our supporting churches. Your prayers and financial support are so valuable to us. We could not continue to stay active in ministry without you.

We have stayed in touch with our partners on Nukuoro as much as is possible. Pastor Ray's back is almost better now. We received word from Jarson that they will be returning to Nukuoro on the next ship down from Pohnpei. Unfortunately, we do not know when that will be. The ship schedule is very sporadic. Hopefully, it will return before Christmas.

The crate we shipped in September arrived in California and will go out to Pohnpei within the next month. We are praying that it will arrive before the ship leaves. Pastor Ray needs the supplies we have on it. These are things they could not purchase on their own. Unfortunately, solar supplies are costly in Pohnpei and are not readily available.

We have tried to stay in touch with the FSM national government and the American Embassy regarding when we can go to the country again but have not received any concrete news yet. Many rumors are being circulated, but we have to get word from the government to know what is happening. Sometimes this is very slow coming. Since the American Embassy has to get its information from the FSM national government, they do not always know either. So please pray that the country will open soon.

The work project in WV at the camp was canceled. However, the church operating the camp purchased their first church building, so now they are working on that instead of the camp. We will be in touch with them to help with both projects.

Thank you for praying for my wife's mother. She fell back in September and broke her pelvis. She spent some time in a rehab center but is now home and doing much better. We are very thankful for that.
