

Our trip to Pennsylvania and West Virginia went much better than we could have imagined. I thought I would only be able to do this as an advisor, but my recovery from the surgery went so well that I was actually able to work some. We were able to get the platform in that church built and put the carpet squares down. It looks wonderful, and the pastor was very excited about the results. The Kutinskys were there with us, and we all had a great time working with the folks there. Please pray for this church as they seek to see souls saved.

After completing the project in Pennsylvania, we drove to Ohio, where we gave an update on the ministry and made the arrangements to travel to their camp and printing ministry in West Virginia. Again, I was able to work while there with no pain! We are so thankful that God has given me healing, which enables me to do much more than I could before. While there, we looked over the whole property, made many recommendations, worked in the print shop on some machinery, and did a lot of work on the grounds. We plan to go there next summer to begin getting things ready for others to come and help. The greatest need right now is housing for those wanting to help with the work. Hopefully, we will be able to help with the youth camp ministry as well when it gets started. I was also asked to be an advisor on their board of directors. Please pray for this ministry, as there will be a lot of work to do. The printing ministry is still operational, and there are plans to update equipment and facilities.

Our plans for this fall involve a kitchen remodel at a church in Louisiana and presenting our ministry to this new church. We are also planning to visit a couple of supporting churches in Georgia to give an update and assist with a bathroom remodel. I am so thankful to be able to help with these projects.

We have still not received a letter from Pastor Ray on Nukuoro. The ship has not gone down yet. It has been a while since they have been able to get supplies in, so we know they are anxious to see the ship. When we were on the island, the highlight of the year was the ship's arrival.
