Dear Faithful Prayer Partners,

Thank you all for your prayers for us this year. We left home on January 20 for Tucson, AZ. The trip was a hard one because we were trying to beat the snow and ice storm that was moving from one end of the nation to the other. We managed to stay ahead of it and arrived in Tucson on the 23rd. We went right to work and were able to do many of the things this church needed. We built baptistry steps for the portable baptistry, four 8 ft. tall bookshelves for the pastor's office, a modesty wall in the ladies' restroom, a storage closet in the church, shelving in the storage garage, and many other smaller projects. We worked 10 hours a day, most days, 6 days a week. God gave us strength each day. We were also able to visit new churches. One was in Yuma and the other in Sahuarita. We have been invited back to both churches to help with work projects for them next year.

On the way out to Tucson, our truck experienced some trouble. We were able to get it fixed for about \$700.00. God provided the funds for this unexpected repair. However, on our way out of Tucson, we experienced another problem with our truck. We are praying about whether or not we should try to replace this truck. Having a truck payment would be a hardship, but being without a reliable truck would stop our ministry, so we really need prayer concerning this matter. The truck is a 2019 and has some mileage on it now. Please pray that God would clearly show us the path we need to take.

Our plans for this spring are in place. We will be giving an update at some of our supporting churches in March and April. Family Fellowship week with our mission board is also in April. There are a few doctors' appointments and a graduation to go to in May. In June, we plan to be in West Virginia working at Gleanings for Christ. There are some camper sites to be put in and a dorm building to be turned into a family dwelling. These are just two of the many projects there. Later this summer, we have been asked to return to Wyoming to help with the enlargement of the sanctuary of the church. This will take us into early fall.

As you can see, there is no shortage of work to do. We covet your prayers for safety in work and travel as well as good health and strength. Pray for those we have been able to witness to along the way, and for a few we are helping to disciple. Please continue to uphold Pastor Ray in Nukuoro in your prayers. We are still praying that God will burden someone else to go there and carry on the work.
