Dear Friends,

Thank you for your faithful prayers for us. We are so grateful to know that you pray for our needs, safety, and strength as we seek to serve the Lord in what He has called us to do. In our last prayer letter, we told you of our busy schedule, and it is indeed busy, so keep on praying.

We are now in WV at Gleanings for Christ. We have cleared some land of overgrowth to lay down water and sewer pipes for the campsites we will be installing here. Trees have been cleared and hauled away, and we have done a lot of weed eating. The Lord has been good to give us cloud cover on most days but no rain. A group from the church that runs this ministry will be here this weekend to help with tasks that require more manpower. So we are hoping to knock out a great deal of things. Next week, we will begin planning to turn a small building here into a small home for folks to stay in when they come to work in the ministry. Please pray that the Gleanings for Christ ministry will receive the needed funds for this, as well as for safety and wisdom for the work.

Our trip to Wyoming will be in either late August or early September. We are still working out the details with some folks who want to help with this project. The church there is expanding its sanctuary and will need some help with the inside work. Please pray for good weather as we all travel there. This part of Wyoming begins to get cool in September – at least by our estimation.

In late October, we will be heading to Florida to do some work on one of our supporting churches. These folks have been a huge blessing to us over the years as they have continually prayed and sent finances.

Work on Nukuoro continues, and we are beginning to plan for a trip to Pohnpei next year. Please, please pray that the ship will make a trip to Nukuoro while we are there so we can go down and visit the people there. Also keep finances for this in prayer. Airline tickets have really gone up. We will also have to arrange for housing on Pohnpei and transportation. We hope to be there for 6 to 8 weeks, depending on a few variables. There are several churches on Pohnpei where we have ministered, and it would be wonderful to see old friends. Our main desire is to travel to Nukuoro to visit our church there. So pray, pray, pray.

We appreciate all of you who pray and financially give so we can go. You are such a blessing to us. God will certainly apply all that is accomplished to your accounts. Many churches and ministries are seeing growth because of your gifts.

May the Lord continue to bless you all.
