Lord willing, I will be preaching a Sunday morning sermon online for New Life Baptist Church in Santo Domingo in a few weeks as well. We are currently at 63% in our support levels and are excited about what the Lord is doing. Thank you all so much for your continued support and prayers. You are continually in our prayers. We love you and praise God for you all.
