We had a great turnout with several first-time visitors, and from that service we have had two families that have continued to attend regularly. September the 7th we celebrated our one-year anniversary from when we first began to hold services for Emmanuel Baptist Church. It was a very special time of remembering all the wonderful things that God has done over the past year. I shared with our Church a video of our beginning to where God has brought us to. We began with just our family, several services in a row where it was just us. I would preach to our family in English because there were no Dominicans attending at the time. After a few weeks, two older ladies began to attend, and little by little, the work has continued to grow. We have taken the time to go over important doctrines and practices of the Church in our services. After doing a study on tithing, we plan to add this into our services on October 12th along with a baptism after our Sunday morning service. Lord willing, there will be at least two of our teenagers who will be getting baptized that Sunday that have given professions of faith. Albeit we have been going over many fundamental doctrines of the Church, especially salvation, since our beginning, I am planning on starting a discipleship course for our entire Church. At the end of which, we plan to address Church membership.

Brittany has begun advancing her Spanish by taking extra Spanish classes throughout the week. Everyone is in good health, and we are thankful for all your prayers and support. It happened at a time we were not home. Thankfully, nothing was taken that we are aware of, and there was minimal damage to one of our windows. Not long after, one of our supporting Churches reached out to us asking if there were any needs we had. Through their help among others, we have been able to increase security by installing bars on our windows and cameras on our property giving us a greater peace of mind.
