She was going stay up at camp and sleep in a room normally reserved for the guest speaker so she wouldn't have to keep driving up a down the mountain each day, but the room already had a special guest, a little mouse! It made itself known as she was getting ready for bed and all she could think about is that mouse running across her face in the night. Millie's Friday ladies Bible study is off to a good start. She potentially has a new lady coming once she recovers from hip surgery. This lady learned about the Bible study from <u>Maria</u>,

one of the LDS ladies that has been coming to her study and has also coming periodically to our morning service with her husband <u>Mike</u>. Maria recently told Millie that, "she doesn't have any peace." Please continue to **pray**, that not only she but and the other LDS ladies that come to the ladies' Bible study and Mike will recognize that true peace only comes through faith alone Jesus Christ of the Bible. On top of Millie the regular ladies Bible study there are two ladies in our church that she is having a discipleship Bible study with. She is taking them though the "New Life in Christ" discipleship book. Millie told <u>Maria</u> that she'll be glad to go through the same book with her once she goes through it with <u>Laura and Shirleen</u>.

On a final note, the gentleman <u>Dave</u> that has been coming joined the church in July. He has been a great help to me on special work projects and he is willing to go door to door. They are currently renting their daughter's spare house here in town and are not sure how long they will be here but plan to come to church here while they live here.
