Dear Praying Friends,

We are presently in the process of packing up the house as the Lord has brought a buyer for our house and we are set to close on the sale on Nov. 17th. We were also able to locate a house that will meet our needs in La Verkin, which is about twenty-three minutes north of the church, and we are set to close on that house on Nov. 20th and move the next day. We had been asking the Lord for a house in Washington Co. whereby we could take our horse, but we were also asking Him to find the right person to hand her over to if that wasn't possible. The Lord allowed us to find a house in Enoch, in Iron Co., which was horse property, but is about forty-five minutes north of Washington, and we actually put an offer on it. It was a couple hours later the pastor who assumed the pastorate of our church plant back in December texted and asked if Millie was serious about letting his son-in-law have her horse. We've known this young man and his family for a number of years, and they are "horse people" and we believed this would be the best option for us as this allows us to be closer to the church and more easily laboring in the ministry. This wasn't a decision without great emotion as it not only involved letting Millie's horse go but it also means we will be leaving a country style of living for a city style of living, but we know it is the best decision. Please be in prayer for us as we make this long-awaited transition to Washington Co.

One of the things that has laid heavy on our hearts is the urgency to get moved so we could begin our door-to-door canvassing sowing the gospel, seeing souls saved, and the church growing. It has been nice over the summer to see people that were on vacation drop in on Sunday mornings (Zion National Park is about forty-five minutes from the church). Reality of the church's state was highlighted each following Sunday when there wasn't an influx of visitors. Please be in **prayer** that once we are able to hit the road we'll find open hearts to the gospel.

In February Brother Scott Carsley and his team from Edge Christian Camp are coming out to do a youth camp at the church. They are also going to be installing new flooring in the hallway and fellowship hall and going door-to-door canvassing. We are excited about what the Lord is going to do through this multifaceted outreach. We are grateful for the opportunity they have presented to Grace Baptist Church. Please keep this upcoming event before the Lord in **prayer** as well.

Millie and I are very grateful for all the prayers that have been offered up on our behalf this

past year. We are equally grateful for each church and individual that has sacrificially given financially so that we are able to continue serving here in Utah. We pray each week for you, and it is our prayer that the Lord will give you fruit for your labors souls for your hire. It is also our prayer that you will have a wonderful Thanksgiving and a blessed Christmas season.
