Dear Praying Friends,

We praise the Lord for all the work the Lord has helped us accomplish since the first of the year and in particular since our last prayer letter. Previous to Edge2Go's arrival in mid-February we had canvassed over three thousand homes and with their help we canvassed an additional one thousand homes. With our planned outreach this coming Saturday, our fifty-two hundred card supply will be depleted, and we'll have to order our next batch. We are grateful for all the church family that have enthusiastically hit the pavement with us each week. We appreciate the younger family in the church faithfully engaging the work, but we are challenged all the more to keep at it by the two couples that are pushing eighty who have helped and even more so by one of the men that is battling Parkinson's who does what he can. Please be in **prayer** with us that the Lord will open hearts to the Gospel.

In addition to canvassing, the goal of having the flooring replaced and sound system upgraded was also accomplished. We are grateful to our home church for supplying the funds for the sound system and for the Edge ministry providing the various outdoor game items. On the first night of the youth outreach, we had eighteen teens in attendance. The rest of the week was a challenge as the attendance ranged from three to eight. The teens that came certainly heard God's Word presented clearly by several of the Edge men. In addition to a youth focus we had a special Saturday morning service with Pastor Gray and Brother Scott challenging the adults with family and service messages. On Sunday the church celebrated its 40th anniversary. The Edge group and some of our folk formed a choir and Pastor Gray preached our morning and evening services. Overall, it was a great week! The folks here enjoyed the partnered labor, fellowship and worship.

It has been said, "God will bring people not targeted on purpose by our outreach efforts as we obey the great commission" and that has once again proven true. Patty recently moved from CA and was out looking for a church that has a Sunday evening service. She told us that the first church she stopped at didn't have an evening service and the Lord spurred on her to keep driving, which ultimately brought her through our doors. She is a home-healthcare-worker and only had Sunday evenings available to come to church, that is until last week. She was praying the Lord would move upon her employer's hearts to give her Sunday's off and she told us this past Sunday that the Lord answered her prayers. She is hoping to bring her mom Resurrection Sunday evening as her mom attends the Catholic church. Please be in **prayer** that her mom will come and that the Lord will do a perfect work in her heart. In addition to Patty, Van and June started attending two weeks ago. Please be in **prayer** we'll also see some young couples with young families start coming and that we'll be able to reach the lost in our community.

We are truly grateful for your faithful prayers and for the faithful financial support of each church

and individual. It is our prayer that the Lord will continue to give you fruit for your labors.
