The last few weeks have been tense politically here in Santa Cruz. The division between the eastern and western sides of the country is becoming more intense. Things have calmed down a bit and we want to let you know some needs for prayer.

We have begun a children's club in 27 de Mayo on Saturdays. We feel this is a way to begin to influence the children before they fall prey to the many temptations of the area. We also hope to reach their parents and influence in the homes. Many of the children are starved for love and attention. Please pray that God's word would have an impact on them.

In Toronjal the men continue to prepare themselves for leadership. They have been attending classes of training and show a real love for the Lord's work. They are looking for a property for the church and are having benches made to accommodate new people. We are encouraged by their zeal to go on. Pray for an evangelistic campaign we plan for November.

We have found a new openness among our neighbors as the political tension has arisen. Many of our neighbors were unknown to us as they live behind walls and very rarely even come to the door. Yet this scare has made people much more open. We are planning to invite those who wish to come to a Bible study in our home. We have been praying for some time for an opening and it seems the Lord is providing it. Thank you for your prayer that God's word would penetrate this group.

Also please pray for the workers in a construction site next to our house. Pray the Lord would use the tracts they have been given to speak to their hearts.
