Dear Friends, Family, and Supporting Churches,

The month of May has been an exciting month. We have traveled to a mission's conference, a camp meeting, a pastor's fellowship, filled in for a pastor while he was out of town for a week, and presented in 4 other churches crossing 2,600 miles for the month. We are extremely thankful to have two more churches partner with us, Pastor Hatley of Fellowship Baptist Church in Maryville, Tennessee, and Dr. Stinson of Southside Baptist Temple of Richmond, Virginia! We had two other churches that voted to partner with us that will be sending their support in June. Our support for the month of May has increased from 10% to 12.6%.
