Dear Pastor, Friends and Supporting Churches,

We are praising the Lord for increasing our support to 81%! We only need 19%, and we will be able to go to Guyana! Yes, we are excited to be so close. We are \$1,140 a month away from planting new churches, training church planters, starting and teaching in the Bible Institute, and shipping a tractor trailer container of Scripture to Guyana once a year! We are looking forward to being part of reaching Guyana with this Generation. If you would like to be part of changing a country for Christ, then please partner with us in prayer and financial support.

We are thankful to partner with Grace Baptist Church in Portland, Maine, with Pastor Ouellette, Heritage Baptist Church in Culpepper, Virginia, with Pastor Fincham, and Fellowship Baptist Church in Upper Marlboro, Maryland, with Pastor Schneider! Brookhaven Baptist Church in Greensboro, North Carolina, with Pastor Fred Daniel, Jr. for Family Fellowship Week. The theme was "Choosing Joy," and it was a tremendous encouragement to our family. Thank you to Pastor Daniel and Brookhaven Baptist Church for doing a fabulous job hosting 150 additional people that week!

I have had pastors tell me that they are not able to help on a monthly basis, but could help with a project that might arise. Here are some opportunities to be a blessing. First, we will have to pay the immigration fees to have Vashtee become an American citizen. She is a citizen of Trinidad, where she was born and was raised. She has her United States Green Card and qualifies to apply for citizenship. With her green card, she is not allowed to be outside of the USA longer than 6 months, thus the need for her citizenship. Vashtee has to mail in Form N-400 and pay for Biometrics Services. The Form N-400 costs \$595 and the Biometric Services costs \$85. Secondly, we are working on raising the remaining \$6,300 to ship our container of Scripture and personal goods to Guyana. We would appreciate however the Lord may lay on your heart to help with these projects.
