Dear Pastor, Friends and Supporting Churches,

The month of November was a glorious month for Faith Baptist Church of Georgetown, Guyana! We have several praises to share with you.

- This past month we had a Sunday morning high attendance of 63.
- We have been offered a 36 passenger bus for \$5,000 U.S. dollars. Currently, we are paying for a mini-bus and several taxis have to bring our two bus routes in Cummings Lodge and Sophia.
- Eleven were saved during one of the mid-week services.
- We had a high attendance of 39 for the weekly Friday night youth night with an average of 35 every week.
- The Sundays are averaging the 40's for attendance.
- Mrs. Vashtee had 18 ladies come to the church's first Ladies' Meeting!
- Our two bus routes in Cummings Lodge and Sophia are growing! Half of the church's youth group visits with us every Saturday morning in Sophia.
- Pray for David and Wayne. They are 2 young men in our youth group that have recently asked to visit in the afternoon on Saturdays. They recently walked over 2 miles to church because they thought the bus was not coming to pick them up for church.
- We are actively looking for land to build the new building for Faith Baptist Church. We would appreciate you praying for the Lord to work out the location and details.
- We have started having a Sunday school for ages 7 and under during the preaching time. Mrs. Vashtee and a young lady from our youth group take the group upstairs. It has grown to 15 children.

We will be shipping a 40 foot container of Gospel tracts in February 2017. Bible Literature and Missionary Foundation of Shelbyville, Tennessee, with Brother Bobby and Brother Shannon Lemmons are providing the tracts. The Scriptures and tracts from our 1st container are almost completely passed out. We look forward to continuing to share the Gospel in Guyana! Brother Keith Davidson with Seedline International is assisting with the paperwork for shipping the container. Faith Baptist Church has been given its non-profit status by the government of Guyana. Lord willing, we should not have to pay any customs fees on this container.
