It is very discouraging that the churches were left closed, while all the establishments were left open. Our churches are greatly affected, and the internet is the only avenue to do the church services. I believe we will go back to a stricter quarantine because of the mishandled cases of COVID-19 in the provinces."

Some of the pastors have been able to make specific visits to church members' homes to do a Bible study, though they aren't able to have regular church services. Pastor Nelvin Mortega sent pictures to me of a Bible study he conducted at a church member's home, and seven precious folks were born again. Amid extreme circumstances, the Gospel is still preached! Pastor Hubert Hernandez, from one of the new churches that have been planted, sent pictures of a Bible study he conducted at a church member's home and notified me the number of people attending the Bible study is growing! Praise the Lord! Please keep Pastor Sammy Medina, the pastors of the Faith Baptist Church, and families in your prayers as they continue to seek to share the Gospel in difficult circumstances due to COVID-19, their government's handling, and enforcing of quarantine across the country.

Please pray for the Lord to fill our schedule for the remainder of 2020 and into 2021. We thank the Lord for increasing our family's support to 39%! Hallelujah! We look forward to the Lord continuing to open doors of opportunity and to magnify Who He is!
