First we are very excited that the mother of Kohaku, our English student, named Yasuko Mizuma, received the Lord as her savior! God was really at work. Because of several things we were led to move the Mizuma family from our Saturday morning class to a night class with another family that seamed very interested in the Bible. This way Mrs. Mizuma could sit in on the Bible time. It was not long after that she admitted to April that she did not have any reason not to repent and accept the Lord. It was so exciting to hear Mrs. Mizuma talk about the Lord, and the last time we saw her, she spoke of how dead she had been spiritually but now how alive she is in Christ. Then about a month later Kohaku's little sister, Ao, accepted Christ as well! Now the father is the only one left in the family not saved. Please pray for Mr. Nori Mizuma. We had their family in our home for an evening and were able to witness to him, but he still is questioning it all. We are praying that he will get off work and decide to come to our church on father's day and be saved.

God's Provision

Another great joy and blessing is how God has provided for our house. For those of you who might not know, when we first moved to Japan the Lord led us to start renting an old but large Japanese home that needed a lot of work to it including replacing windows, old electric, plumbing, and putting in insulation (there was none) and dry walling over the mud walls. We were able to rent it much cheaper and for as long as we want. We have been slowly fixing it up over the last 4 years. In April John and Rachel King came from a supporting church in Michigan for two weeks to help work on our living room and study. They were a great encouragement and much of it was done by the time they had to return. We are so grateful to them for their help and to another couple in Indiana and a supporting church in Florida who provided for the funds to be able to do all this. We are still overwhelmed with their generosity. We pray that the Lord will really use this space for His glory and bringing Japanese to Him. Please pray for our next project to finish the exterior of the house.

planning to come again on Father's day so please be in prayer for that. Our church will also be singing again at the old hospital that afternoon so pray for God's working and open doors to witness there.




New Opportunities
