

As we saw this great blessing we also faced some trials. A lady in our church who had been backslidden and just

returned to church this year almost tried to commit suicide. The Lord guided us and thankfully she has turned around spiritually. She raised her hand during an invitation and afterward was able to receive assurance of her salvation and now wants to live for God. Please pray that God will continue to guide us as we counsel Mrs. R. This is yet another reminder of the suppressive culture we live in and the great need to reach the people here with the Gospel. Japan sees more deaths from suicide than any other cause. This is definitely the devil's work blinding people from the glorious gospel of Christ. We pray that the Lord will grant spiritual victory for the lost and for the people in our church as they face the cultural difficulties of being a Christian in Japan.

After this God blessed again this month when we were able to lead two more of our English students to Jesus. One had prayed before and wanted to make sure. Now little Ao and Rion are on their way to heaven! This was a testimony to Rion's mother as she had never really thought of Jesus before. April was able to talk to all three mothers about the decisions their daughters made. Please pray for these girls and their mothers as well as all our English Students.
