In our last letter we asked prayer for <u>Yuichi's spiritual</u> <u>growth and for their family</u> to find a larger apartment. We praise the Lord that they were able to find a large government apartment and Yuichi came to church last Sunday. However, because of Covid, he has lost his job. Because he doesn't have a driver's license, the only job available is far away. In Japan, it can easily cost \$3,000 to get a License for the first time. He is planning to work this job living away from his family for the 6month contract so that he can get his license and get a job here is Saku. However, his wife, Rose, who has 3 children already, is pregnant now with twins and will be due the month Yuichi returns. <u>Please uplift them all in your prayers.</u>
