We praise the Lord that Japan is starting to open up their border which has been closed to new foreigners for most of the pandemic. <u>The Derry and White Family</u> are working on their paperwork now so that we can get their certificate of eligibility to apply for visas so they can move here. They plan to minister with us until they learn Japanese and then go to start new churches here in Nagano prefecture. <u>Please pray for them to be able to get the remainder of their needed support, finish up their deputation and make all the preparations for them to come to the mission field. The Whites have their tickets already to come in August for 3-4 weeks and then, Lord willing they will be moving over officially in January of 2023.</u>
