Dear friends,

Our recent experiences have reminded us of the tenth chapter of the book of John where Jesus told the parable of the sheepfold, the thief, and the shepherd. In the same chapter, Jesus explains that He is the Good Shepherd who gives eternal life to His sheep and that the thief only comes to kill and destroy the sheep.

One Sunday in May, a man named Yusuf was sitting on the ground in the park where we meet for Bible study. One of our faithful men went to the Yusuf and invited him to join us for our Bible study.
