We were able to participate in some fun activities as well – men's and ladies' shopping, Saturday at the park with the church family, a family outing to the Wright Brothers memorial, the teen's

miniature golf outing, fishing in the ocean, and visiting the coast on Corolla Beach to see the wild Spanish horses with our host family. Heather and I thoroughly enjoyed a date night on Saturday evening — a "strongly encouraged gift" from the Still Waters church family - for which we are truly thankful amidst the busy deputation travels. We felt truly "spoiled" during the Conference.

We also are praising the Lord that 800 pounds of Bibles were shipped in March and April. A senior pastor and his wife received three boxes in Mindanao, Philippines.
